


At nearly 9,000 kilometers from France in the UN Memorial Cemetery 44 French fallen soldiers, including a French unknown soldier, remained buried in this cemetery following the wishes of their families.



In the UNMCK, there is also a Memorial wall of all the UN soldiers who died during the conflict. Among others, there is a plaque dedicated to France with the names of the 269 soldiers killed in action.
